#### CERTIFICATE TIMELINE

The Advanced Certificate in Information Systems is designed to satisfy the professional needs of students who wish to acquire graduate-level knowledge in Information Systems (IS), but who do not wish to pursue a full graduate degree.

The certificate program allows individuals who generally have little or no formal education in IS to develop an advanced level academic experience in IS as an adjunct to their prior degree.

#### FORMAT

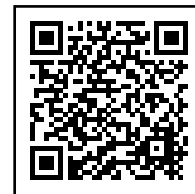
