Earn your master's degree while teaching! The MS in Educational degree program prepares innovative, inclusive educators who promote success and the social good. Classes are held online to give you the ultimate flexibility while working and studying.

- ▶ Complete the program part-time in just 16 months.
- ▶ Fulfills academic requirements for New York State Professional Teaching Certification for teachers who already have Initial Teaching Certification.
- ▶ Electronic Portfolio Development Create a multimedia, standards-based online document, which demonstrates the professional knowledge and skills you have developed based on the National Board of Professional Teaching and InTASC Standards.
- ▶ MSEd includes courses on social-emotional contexts, data-based decision-making, and teaching English learners.
- ▶ Personalized program with tracks in Childhood Education or Adolescent Education.

Track 1 meets the requirements for Professional Certification in Childhood Education (Grades 1-6) for teachers with Initial Certification in this area.

Track 2 is designed for teachers with Initial Certification in one of the Adolescence Education content areas (History, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, French, Spanish, and English), meets the requirements for Professional Certification in Adolescence (Grades 7-12), and also leads to Middle School Extension certification (Grades 5-6).

ACCREDITATION

Marist teacher preparation programs at the Initial Certification and Advanced Certification levels are registered with the New York State Education Department (NYSED). Marist is a member of the Association for Advancing Quality in Educator Preparation (AAQEP).

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ► Graduate admissions application (available online)
- Official undergraduate/graduate transcripts from all institutions attended
- ▶ Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA required
- ➤ Two letters of recommendation (one from a former professor, one from your cooperating teacher or work supervisor at a school
- ▶ Resumé
- ▶ Personal statement (about 750 words describing your background, experiences, goals, and how these relate to your work in education)
- ▶ NYS Initial Teaching Certification must be in progress or completed to attend this program.

Qualified candidates will be asked to have an interview in person or by phone with the Program Director. The interview process may require a short written task.
