## **Biosafety**

The policy on biosafety applies to all research, teaching, and other operations of the College involving:

- gene-splicing techniques, construction and handling of recombinant DNA molecules, and use of organisms or viruses containing recombinant DNA
- 2. infectious microorganisms
- 3. the disposal of infectious or hazardous waste, or
- 4. hazardous and/or toxic chemicals, including carcinogens

Investigators are responsible for ensuring safety in activities involving recombinant DNA or gene-splicing techniques, infectious microorganisms, infectious waste, or hazardous and toxic chemicals. Questions concerning biosafety policy should be directed to the Office of Safety and Security.
