## **Biosafety**

The policy on biosafety applies to all research, teaching, and other operations of the College involving:

1. gene-splicing techniques, construction and handling of recombinant DNA molecules, and use of organisms or viruses containing recombinant DNA
2. infectious microorganisms
3. the disposal of infectious or hazardous waste, or
4. hazardous and/or toxic chemicals, including carcinogens

Investigators are responsible for ensuring safety in activities involving recombinant DNA or gene-splicing techniques, infectious microorganisms, infectious waste, or hazardous and toxic chemicals. Questions concerning biosafety policy should be directed to the Office of Safety and Security.
