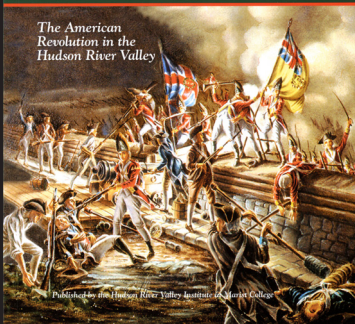

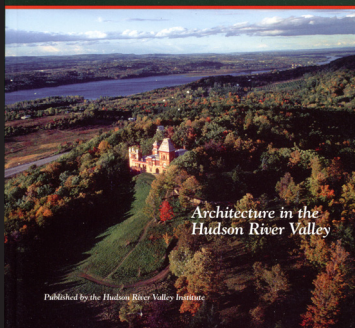

Founded at Bard College in 1984 as the *Hudson Valley Regional Review (HVRR)*, it was published under that name until 2001 when the College decided to discontinue publication. **The Hudson River Valley Institute** is proud to continue the tradition under its new name.

The *Review* remains essentially unchanged; covering topics of regional interest with essays, poems, photographs, paintings, historic documents, and book and art reviews. And we are always ready to consider other forms of intellectual achievement. It is still published twice a year, Spring and Autumn, and it is still the same convenient size that it has always been.

But we have made some changes. We added a full-color cover featuring images and artifacts from throughout the region. 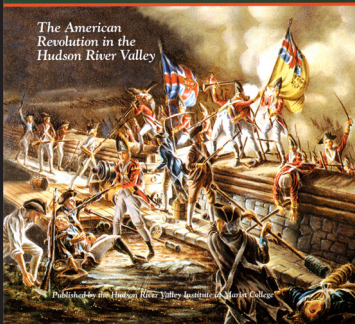

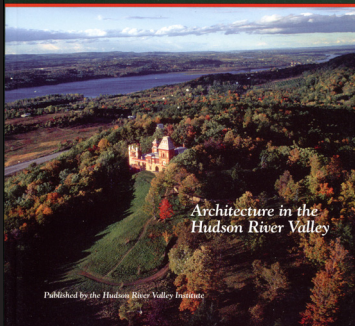
