

# Registration

### You must register to reserve your place in classes.

- Send official, hard copy transcripts and complete your deposit before you are allowed to register.
- Registration starts in April for Fall/August admission. Registration starts in November for Spring/January admission.
  - You will receive an email when it is time to register for classes. Reply to that email to register.
- Once classes are filled, we will not allow other students to join Marist that semester.
- If classes fill, we will have a waiting list for students who want to register.
- Students on the waiting list are not guaranteed attendance. They may need to defer to the next Fall or Spring semester.

#### **First Semester Classes**

MSIS students will have three of the four following classes assigned during the first semester.

- Systems & Information Concepts in Organizations
- Data Management I
- Data Communications
- Systems Analysis and Design

MSCS students will have the three following classes assigned during the first semester.

- Object-Oriented Programming in Java
  - Students who pass the placement exam with a "B" or better will be given an alternate class in their Concentration
- Software Design & Development
- Database Management Systems

The first semester classes will be assigned by your Program Director. You will have flexibility with classes starting in your second semester.

### **On Campus Classes**

Two or more classes must be on campus to meet with your F-1 VISA requirements.

One class per semester may be taken online if you are in the MS in Information Systems degree. All classes are on campus for MSCS.
