


# Installing Office 365 on macOS

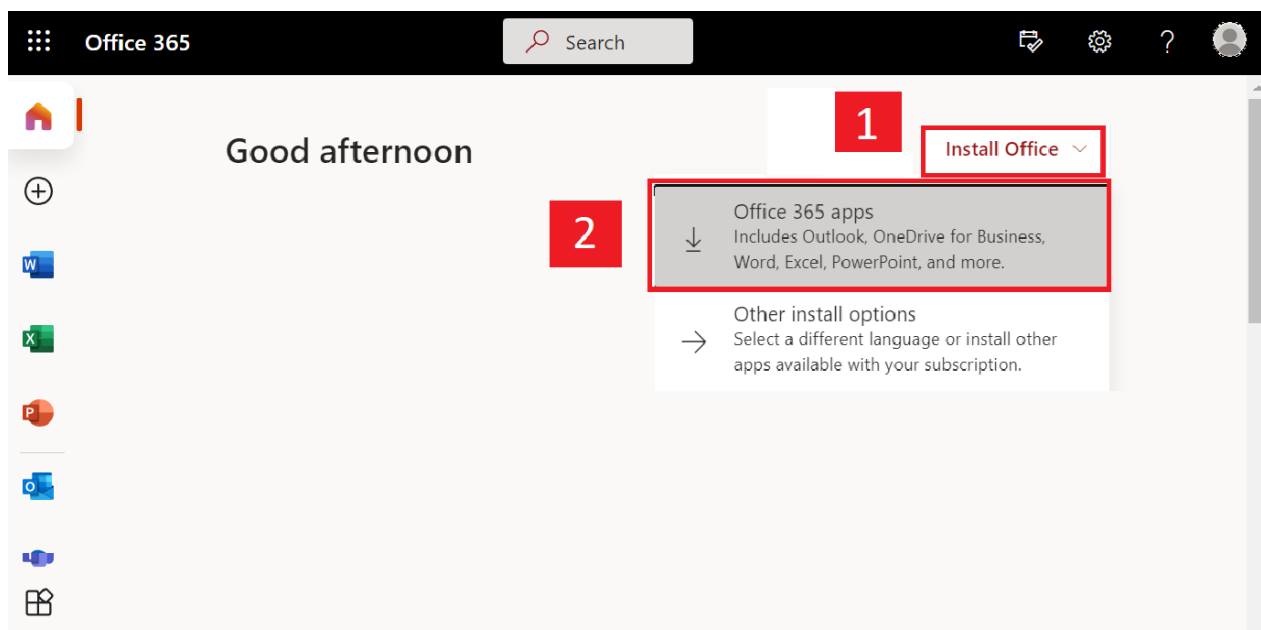
Office 365 for Mac includes the following apps and services: Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Outlook, OneDrive (1 TB of cloud storage), and Teams.

1. Go to [myemail.marist.edu](https://myemail.marist.edu) and sign in with your Marist account:

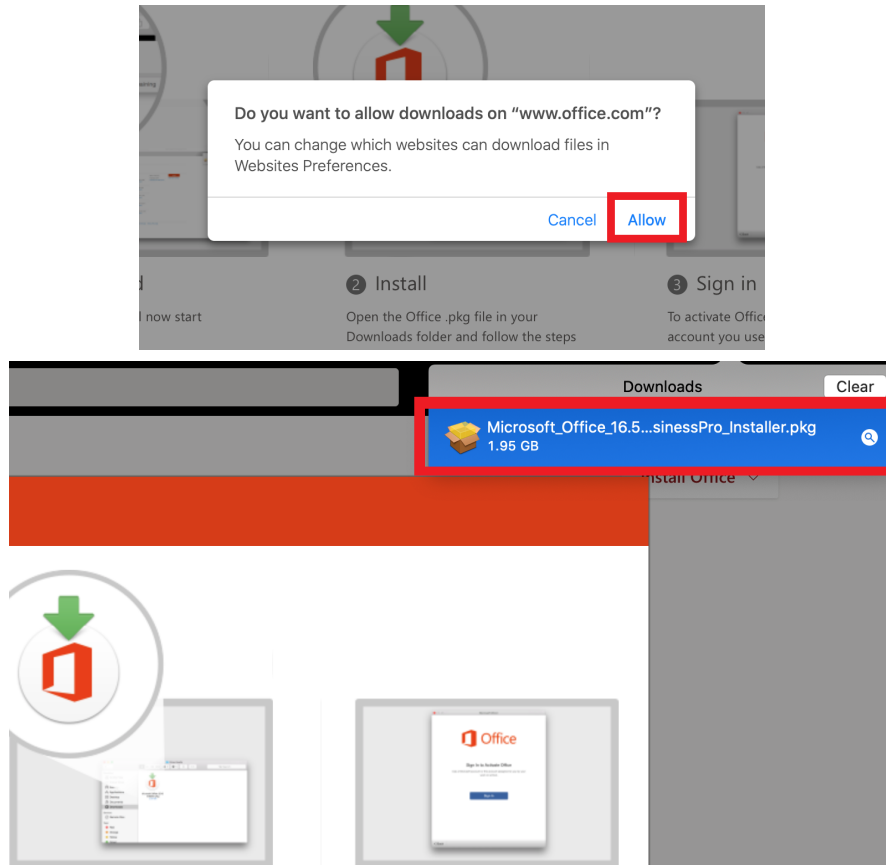

2. In the upper-right corner of the page, click **Install Office > Office 365 Apps**.
