Principal Investigator Eligibility

Marist College's policy requires the Principal Investigator of external grants and contracts to be a permanent employee (faculty member or staff member) of the College at the time of proposal submission.

In special circumstances, non-Marist employees may serve as Co-Principal Investigators. This requires a written agreement between either (1) the College and the non-Marist employee, or (2) the College and the non-Marist employee's institution. The agreement should outline both the commitment and the responsibility of the individual and the institution to the project.

This written agreement normally takes the form of a subcontract with the institution where the non-Marist faculty member is employed.
