HISTORY SCHOLARSHIPS

Marist-Gilder Lehrman Institute of American History (GLI) Scholarship

We believe that history students who are determined to make an impact with their studies should be granted the resources to do so. The newly established Marist-Gilder Lehrman Institute of American History (GLI) Scholarship is awarded to high-achieving students who demonstrate a strong interest in history. All incoming freshman history majors are eligible for one of four scholarships ranging from \$10,000 to full tuition, room, and board.

As a Marist-GLI scholar, students will have access to the Gilder Lehrman Collection, which spans over 500 years and contains some of the most important repositories of American History, from politics to society to economics. With an array of primary resources for students, scholars, and educators, the Collection serves additional value through exhibitions, videos, research, and much more. Students will be able to participate in a variety of special programming, such as trips to Hamilton on Broadway, and the Franklin D. Roosevelt Presidential Library, to name a few. In addition, they will receive special advising from the academic dean, and be well-positioned for unique internships, study abroad opportunities, as well as post-graduate fellowship awards. Scholarships are renewable for their four undergraduate years of study.

LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIPS

At Marist, we are helping prepare the next generation of leaders by providing students with the resources to realize their leadership potential. Marist offers several scholarships geared towards emerging leaders. Past recipients of these awards include class National Merit finalists, student body presidents, school newspaper editors, Eagle Scouts, Gold Award recipients, athletic team captains, and other young leaders.

Peter P. O’Keefe, PhD Endowed Scholarship

The Peter P. O’Keefe, PhD Endowed Scholarship provides full financial support, including tuition, room, and board, to high-achieving students who have demonstrated potential as a future leader and would not otherwise be financially able to attend Marist. Scholarships are renewable for their four undergraduate years of study.

Dennis & Marilyn Murray Endowed Scholarship

The Dennis & Marilyn Murray Endowed Scholarship, which offers a full tuition scholarship to students, is designed to provide emerging leaders with the opportunity to foster their skills and achieve their fullest potential as successful professionals in leadership roles. Scholarships are renewable for their four undergraduate years of study.



SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIPS

National Science Foundation (NSF) Scholarship

Marist’s School of Science invites academically talented students, interested in majoring in Biology, Biochemistry, Chemistry, and Environmental Science, to pursue their passion for science and take advantage of full tuition and room scholarship opportunity. The Gateway to Success program will increase STEM degree completion among high-achieving undergraduates with significant financial need.

In addition to the scholarship, students will receive a laptop, funding for undergraduate research, personalized mentoring and career planning support, the opportunity to engage in STEM-focused campus employment after freshman year, and an invitation to be part of a science-focused living-learning community.

Applicants are required to file a FAFSA, and scholarship finalists will be invited for an interview. Scholarships are renewable for their four undergraduate years of study.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

Award: \$10,000 to \$25,000.

Band and choral scholarships are awarded by the Director of the Music Program. Auditions are required. **Award:** \$2,500 scholarship.

THEATRE SCHOLARSHIPS

Theatre scholarships are awarded by the Director of the Theatre Program. Auditions are required.

Award: \$2,500 scholarship.

ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Awards are based on athletic ability and offered by the head coach of each Division I sport.

ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIPS

Approximately 200 endowed scholarships have been established to support new and returning students.

Award: Scholarships range from \$500 to \$10,000.
